



## Cambodia Group Quest

Cambodia is a fascinating destination and provides a great opportunity for your group to participate in rewarding service work while learning and absorbing the rich history and culture of the country. United Planet's program is based in Siem Reap - situated within the ruins of the ancient Khmer civilization, often collectively referred to as "Angkor Wat", the name of the largest and best-restored temple.

### Project Information

United Planet Group Quest volunteers work with our partner organizations, local NGOs and schools. Possible projects include working in an orphanage, teaching English to children and adults, and plastering and painting school buildings. Several of the schools hold classes after working and school hours, and volunteers may be teaching in the evenings from about 5-7pm.

### Accommodation

Accommodation for groups is at the Monoreach Hotel in Siem Reap, a four-star hotel.
