



Ghana Group Quest

Sokode, where the Quest is centered, is a part of the Ho Municipality, with a population of about 2,400 inhabitants, most of whom are small scale farmers ruled by Chiefs and Queen mothers. Ewe is the main language spoken. Its geographical location makes it easy to access many tourist attractions in the Volta Region. For instance, it is about; 10km from Ho, 20km from Kalakpa Game Reserves, 24km from Kpetoe Kente Weaving village, 60km from Tafi Monkey Sanctuary. There is a secondary technical school to cater for Sokode and its surrounding villages.

Project Information

Your project may involve construction such as helping to build a classroom block for the secondary school, working alongside local community members. You may also choose to teach English.

Accommodations

Depending on when your group visits, you have the option to stay with host families, camp in tents, or live in student dormitories. There will not be hot water, but you can boil water to take a hot bucket shower.

Wli Waterfalls

The waterfalls are 60-80 meters- the highest falls in West Africa. The hills mark the border between Ghana and neighboring Togo. A walk through the forest offers a chance to see a large colony of fruit bats, butterflies, birds, monkeys and baboons.

There are some notable sites in Cape Coast including several forts built between the 18th and 19th century and Cape Coast Castle. Here you will learn history about the slave trade, and it is an emotional visit.
