As a volunteer, you will be working in the beautiful coastal city of Port Elizabeth – a hot-spot for adventurous travelers worldwide.

Projects

Sports Coaching Projects

Volunteers play and coach sports to at-risk youth who are passionate about football/soccer, cricket, rugby, hockey, netball, tennis, basketball, swimming and more. Your group can coach and host a tournament for the schools you work with. As part of the program's life-skills curriculum, volunteers promote good citizenship and health awareness.

Social Projects

Volunteers can work in a number of social projects including teaching, arts and crafts, or orphanage care. Volunteers use creativity and compassion to broaden opportunities for sick, disabled or underprivileged children in the Port Elizabeth area.

Accommodations

Volunteers stay in a communal accommodation in town, basic but comfortable, with dormitory style rooms and shared bathrooms. Meals are provided in a dining room. The accommodation has a sociable atmosphere, and volunteers find it a great place to relax and unwind in the evenings, with a swimming pool and lots of activities (such as ping pong, TV/DVD room, pool table, and more). The house is centrally located to the placements and not far from the city centre, shopping centers (within walking distance), the beach and night life. A staff member stays on site to address any needs.

Standard Program Fee

The fee for the standard 10-day group Quest described on the itinerary below is \$1,595.

Your price will differ if you choose to customize your Quest to meet the project, accommodation, and activity interests of your group. One group leader travels for free when recruiting 10 participants.
